

The Blind Spot of the Economy - A Lecture in Times of the Corona Crisis

The Catholic Adult Education in the Diocese of Trier - CEF - organized an online event with Silja Graupe on April 2, 2020 on the topic "The Blind Spot of the Economy".

Year after year almost 20% of all German students crowd into lectures of economics - and learn there neither responsibility nor how to deal with the crises of the present. This is because economic teaching has been standardized worldwide in recent decades, and the same economic method is being taught globally.

Silja Graupe compares this standardization with pilots who just stare at their navigation systems, unable to recognize the real mountain before their plane crashes into it.

In her talk she shows a different way and outlines how the university of the 21st century can enable students to critically reflect on the pressing problems of the time and strengthen their moral decision-making ability and the courage to act prudently, a fundamental prerequisite against the background of current economic and ecological challenges.
